



VISITOR GUIDANCE

We are delighted to welcome you back to our facility! We are excited that visitation is now permissible and that you will have the opportunity to rejoin your loved ones.

In order to ensure the safety of our environment, please follow the following guidelines as it relates to visitation:

- Visitation will be permitted 6 days a week from 2:00pm – 6:00pm in accordance with our “NY Forward Safety Plan”.
- Visitors are required to undergo a health screening upon entry into our facility. Any visitor who fails the screening, will be denied entry.
- Visitors must present a verified “negative” test result within the past 7 days (for each visit with the exception of hospice).
 - If visitor refuses to provide a “negative” test result, has not been tested within the past 7 days, or does not have a “negative” test result within the past 7 days, visitation will be denied.
- Visitors under the age of 18 are ONLY permitted entry if accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Visits will be limited to 30 minutes.
- Visits will be limited to two visitors at any one time for each resident.
- Visits will be limited to our outdoor area (weather permitting).
- Visitors must practice social distancing, wear a face covering throughout the duration of each visit, wash hands thoroughly, and avoid physical contact.
- Visitors are not permitted in resident care areas (hospice and bed-bound exception).
- Total number of visitors cannot exceed 10% of resident census at any time.

Visitation is strictly permitted by appointment only. To schedule an appointment, please visit our website or call 845-623-3904 x 291.

As per the New York State Department of Health, any visitor who fails to adhere to the aforementioned guidance will be prohibited from visiting the facility for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic.
